- Every question in the NEET UG will carry 4 marks
- Each correct answer will fetch 4 marks
- For each incorrect response, there will be a one-mark deduction
- If there is more than one correct answer to a question, then all/any one of the marked MCQ options will be given 4 marks
- Any un-attempted or unanswered question will not receive any marks
- Candidates will be awarded 4 marks in case a question is dropped, irrespective of the fact that the question was attempted by the student or not
